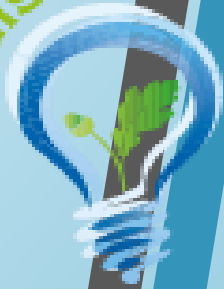

Reception to Year 4

We use Seesaw for school homework in Reception, Year 1, 2,3 & 4. Homework is set up on Fridays and is due back by Wednesdays. Homework can be directly typed up into Seesaw canvas or completed on a piece of paper and picture uploaded.



Please let the class teacher know if your child does not have access to a device at home so we can provide them with a paper-based homework.

Spelling are also given weekly, and children are tested every Friday.



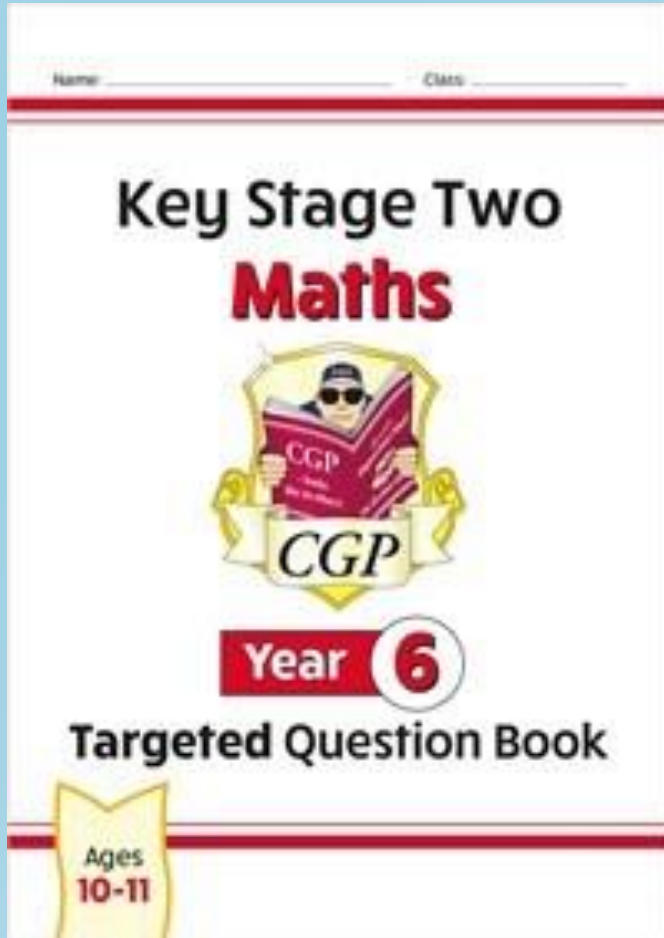
Year 5 & 6

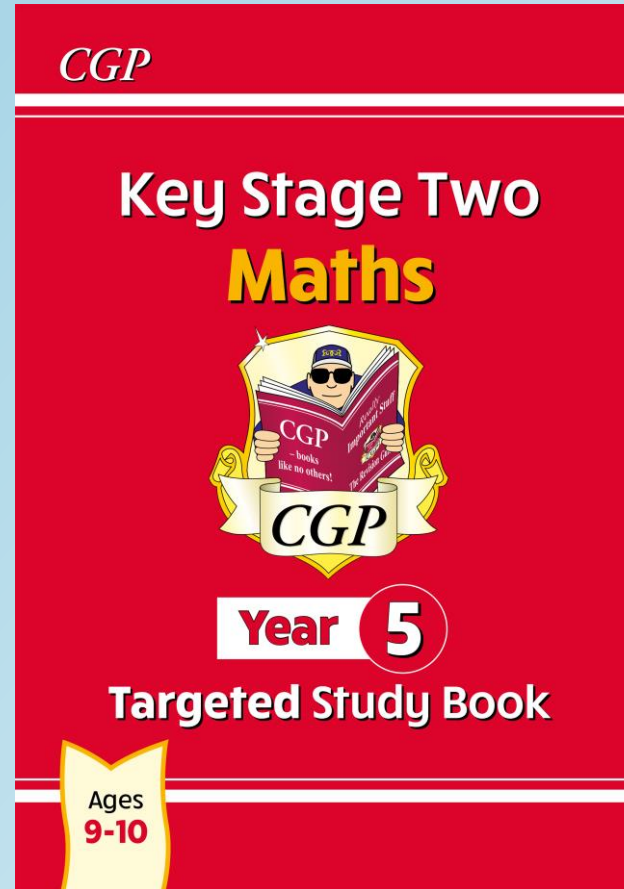

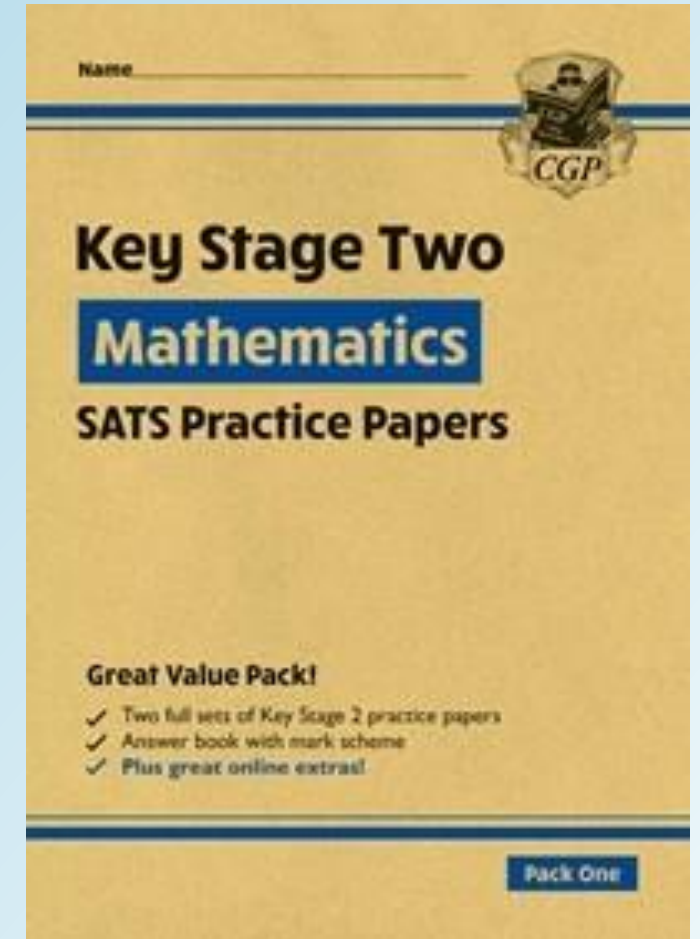

Homework: Reading

Reading is an integral part of the homework. All children must read every day at home. Children in lower school change their books regularly. We ask that adults read with them every day without fail.



For children in upper school, we request that they read independently, for at least 20-30 minutes each day. It is recommended that all children take a quiz on Accelerated Reader once a week, on a book within their ZPD.

We appreciate parents and carers in ensuring that good reading habits are promoted. Please also remember to sign your child's Reading Records each day.





Homework: Timestables

As Children in Year 4 take part in statutory assessment of MTC, we ask that all children use TTRS regularly at home. The recommended time is 1-2 hours per week if your child has still not secured timestables to 12.
